INDIVIDUAL WRITTEN NOTICE TO ALL PATIENTS NOTICE OF AVAILABILITY OF CHARITY CARE

Under its charity care policy, Burke Rehabilitation Hospital will make available a reasonable amount of uncompensated services to persons eligible under applicable Community Service Administration guidelines. Charity care hospital services are available in both the inpatient and outpatient areas. Patient eligibility for charity care is determined by measuring family income against twice (200%) the Income Poverty Guidelines established by the Community Services Administration. The current income requirements are:

These figures represent twice the Income Poverty Guidelines. Sliding scale charity care is available, and ranges from 20% to 80% discounted medical services. If you think you may be eligible for charity care and wish to request it, please make a written request to the Business Office or call (914) 597-2329. The Business Office will make a written determination of eligibility within two working days of your request. If a patient is determined to be not eligible for charity or discounted care, an appeals process is available by contacting the Director of Patient Financial Services (914) 597-2257.
